Accessibility to STEM for Students who are Blind or Visually Impaired





After piloting a half-day program in July 2016, the Center for Nanoscale Science is leading an effort to implement a 4-day STEM Extension to an existing college-transition and preparation program for students who are blind or visually impaired, called Summer Academy. The project builds upon longstanding partnerships with Penn State's Science U summer camp program and instructional staff in the Physics & Chemistry departments.
